HARDY LILIES – Asiatic and L.A Hybrids

Bloom Season: E - early, M - midseason, L - late. Midseason bloom is usually in mid July here.

1(a) - up facing 1(b) - outfacing 1(c) - down facing

All Asiatic and L.A. Hybrid lilies are available for spring and fall shipping. Lilies are traditionally planted in the fall but we find that spring planting is also suitable. They will bloom somewhat later the first year. Martagon and species lilies are shipped in fall only. Asiatic and L.A. hybrid lilies are individually priced or the ones priced at \$5.00 can be obtained at 3 for \$12.00 if 3 of the same variety are ordered and \$6.00 lilies at 3 for \$15.00 if 3 of the same variety are ordered.

The L.A. hybrids are crosses between Asiatic lilies and the well-known Easter or longiflorum lily . These lilies have very large blooms on reasonably tall stems and are quite vigorous. They have proven to be hardy and bloom in midseason. Some have a slight fragrance.

PINK ASIATIC AND L.A. HYBRID LILIES

Aphrodite 1(a) M 34". Soft pink double flowers that are pollenless. Performs particularly well on heavier soils. \$5.00

Baby Pink Bells –1(c) M 32". Dusty rose pink with a few spots. A novelty lily bred by Fred Fellner. \$8.00

Carol Jean –1(a) M 16". Rose pink flowers with brown spots. \$5.00

Coral Butterflies –1(b,c) M 36". Recurved blooms of coral pink poised on tall stems. \$7.00

Dorijo –1(a) E 30". Early upfacing pink with numerous black spots. Buds are large and fuzzy before opening. \$7.00

Dynamico L.A. Hybrid 36". Strong stems with big frosty buds open into deep mauve pink flowers. Later blooming. \$5.00

Embarrassment 1(b,c) M 40". Blushing rose pink with cream toward center. Many blooms per stem. \$8.00

Fairest –1(b,c) M 40". Large, beautifully recurved slightly nodding pastel pink flowers. Buds are deep pink. \$7.00

Gypsy –1(a) M 45". Lovely dusty pink. Unspotted. \$5.00

Honeypink –1(b) M 30". Outstanding outfacing honey pink lily. \$5.00

Melissa Jamie –1(b) EM 34". Peach pink, long bloom period. \$5.00

MoneyMaker L.A. Hybrid- 36". A medium purple pink fades to softer pink at centers. Blooms in late July. \$5.00

Aurelian Hybrids (trumpet x henryi) (Fall Shipping Only)

Bright Star - 36-40". Apricot white with apricot-orange star, recurved petals. Blooms in August. \$9.00

Asiapets (aurelian x asiatic) Fall Shipping Only

Ivory Belles –36". Ivory up and outfacing flowers with slight yellow blush in the center. Outside gray purple. \$8.00

Silky Belles - 36", L. Fine silky white with a greenish hue. Outside is grayish purple. Bowl type flowers. Outfacing flowers with lovely subtle perfume. \$8.00

Species Lilies (Fall Shipping Only)

L. duchartrei – 20". Pendant flowers are beautifully scented and are marble white with scattered wine red spots. This species has small bulbs. \$10.00

L.hansonii –3 to 4'. Fragrant deep yellow flowers of martagon form. Leaves are arranged in whorls, waxy sheen, light shade preferred. \$15.00

L. henryi citrinum - Strong arching stems and thick polished dark green leaves. Nodding yellow flowers with a few chocolate spots. Late blooming (August). Will grow in semi-shade. Up to 6' tall. \$8.00

L. leichtlinii –36". Pendant, citron yellow flowers of reflexed martagon form. Up to 12 flowers per stem. \$10.00

L. leichtlinii maximowiczii –Cinnabar orange, purple spotted Turk's cap flowers, up to 12 per stem. 36". \$10.00

L. pumilum 2'. Produces many small waxy red Turk's-cap flowers on grassy stems. Early blooming. \$6.00

L. tsingtauense Brilliant orange, up and outfacing flowers, whorled shiny leaves. 2 to 3' tall for us. Full sun or partial shade. \$6.00

Martagon Lilies (Fall Shipping Only)

Martagon lilies normally bloom from late June to early July here. Most reach to at least 4 feet tall and may carry as many as 40 or 50 Turks-cap blooms. They are extremely hardy and long lived and will not require division for many years. While not extremely fast to spread, most martagons will clump

up impressively in time to become a permanent fixture in your perennial bed.
Sun or partial shade.

The martagon lilies are grown by Bertha Lardner just northeast of
Edmonton. For viewing these (late June, early July), and for directions
phone Bertha at 780-478-7929.

Akimina A light yellow (creamy white) with orange red spots in the center.
Nectaries slightly deeper yellow, yellow pollen. Larger blooms. \$30.00

Amelita Inside purplish red, outside deep purplish pink. Numerous spots.
Vivid yellow pollen. A real beauty. \$30.00

Attiwaw Yellowish pink with purplish pink tips and strong orange center.
Small purple spots on inner half. Strong grower. \$30.00

Black Prince Very dark mahogany, almost black with a reddish glow at
edge of petals. 42". Rare. \$50.00

Brocade Orange-yellow with an overlay of pink. Rosy pink tips. Looks
glossy pink from a distance. Recommended. \$15.00 3 for \$35.00

Cadense Rich clear yellow with a few spots. Showy and a strong grower.
Dense flower spike. \$25.00

Claude Shride Greyed purple with a few yellow orange spots. Mid green
stems. Prolific and a strong grower. Strong, thick stems. \$25.00

Dalhansonii Chestnut brown with a few gold spots. Very strong grower
with lots of flowers. Tall, early, nice. Delicate lighter center. \$10.00

Early Bird Sunflower yellow with a magenta rose flush. Tiny red spots.
The earliest to bloom. \$20.00

Guinea Gold Buttercup yellow with brown spots. Very pink buds before
opening. Strong grower. Blooms late. \$25.00

L. martagon The original species. Various shades of pinkish-purple. Tiny

Daylilies (Hemerocallis)

For spring and fall shipping.

Daylilies are truly low maintenance perennials. They have very few problems with pests or diseases, are tough and thrive in virtually any type of soil. They do well in sun as well as partial shade. Peak daylily bloom is usually mid July to mid August. Daylilies may be dug at any time during the growing season. You may view them in bloom and may pick up the varieties you choose to purchase at that time, however you must call ahead to make arrangements.

Bandit Man –28". Bright orange with a bold red eye. Tetraploid.

Big Apple –27". Ruffled full bright red flowers.

Blackberry Delight – 24". Ruffled cream apricot, deep gold throat.

Blackberry Parfait –36". Cherry purple blend with gold throat.

Bright Dancer - 34". Brilliant red with a small yellow throat.

Buddha – 30". Black red with a yellow throat.

Calgary Stampede –22" .Red with light cream edges. \$15.00

Chicago Ruby - 27". Red self with green throat, big, sturdy and long blooming.

Christmas Day - 38". Vermilion red with burgundy red eyezone and deep gold throat. Deep glowing colors.

Condilla -20". Bright gold, double flowers. \$12.00

Cool It -20". Large white flowers with a yellow throat.

Countess Carrots -16". Miniature orange with a chartreuse throat.

Darius - 24". Royal purple with darker eyezone and yellow throat. \$12.00

Decatur Bullseye - 34". Gold and mahogany with red eyezone and gold throat.

Decatur Gleam - 28". Large, wide petaled beautifully glowing golden flowers. Extended bloom.

Decatur Special - 32". Deep pink with darker pink eyezone and green throat.

Doll -36". Raspberry pink with a darker eye.

Dominic - 30". Dark blackish-red with a light yellow throat. Vigorous.

Edna Spalding - 28". Slightly ruffled, medium sized clear baby ribbon pink: yellow-green throat.

Elegant Candy -25". Heavily ruffled pink flowers with red eyezone.

Evening Gown - 28". Melon blend with hint of pink, green throat. Beautiful form and floriferous.

Fanciful Finery - 18". Bright double yellow (daffodil like) flowers.

Firefly -18". Red flowers on short plant, vigorous.

Flaming Poppa -25". Vivid flame red bloom with a wide green heart. Vigorous. \$12.00

Golden Prize 26". Huge 7" gold flowers. Award winner. \$12.00

Green Flutter -20". Canary greenish yellow with green throat. Nice contrast to darker daylilies. Flowers appear green.

Hamlet -18". Grape purple with a rich light blue purple halo.

Happy Returns –18". Canary yellow rebloomer from the famous Stella d'Oro. Long bloom period.

Holiday Delight - 28". Black-red with eyezone of orange and dark red. Large blooms.

Hudson Valley –32". Light greenish yellow with a green throat. Fragrant, huge blooms.

Hyperion –36". Large flowers are pale lemon-yellow with a delightful fragrance. Excellent for naturalizing.

Ice Carnival – 28". Wide petaled, near white, diamond dusted, light yellow throat.

Indian Paintbrush –28". Very bright and unusual. Burnt orange veining and deep tangerine throat that blends to gold.

Ivelyn Brown –26". Enormous cream flowers (8").

Ivory Hager – 34". Ivory cream beautifully formed flowers, lightly ruffled, coral black anthers. A very elegant looking flower. \$12.00

Jersey Spider –45". Large 8" spider blooms which are orange with a green throat. Long blooming.

Jewel Russel –26". Copper red with a yellow throat.

Lady Lucille – 24". Bright orange, yellow midrib and throat, prolific bloomer.

Langley Fanfare 26". Bright cherry pink with white rib.

Lavender Deal –24". Deep lavender with chartreuse throat. \$12.00

Lemon Lace –32". Lemon, small green throat. Fragrant.

Leprechauns's Wealth –15". Orange-apricot with olive green throat. Loaded with bloom.

Japanese peonies have large blooms with a row or more of petals surrounding a large center tuft of many stamens, in harmonious and striking combinations. Heights range from 30" to 36" unless otherwise noted. We have found the best success comes from starting with 3 to 5 eye divisions with a generous root mass and that is what we ship (in fall only).

Semp. funckii The 1” to 1.5” wide rosettes are bright green, sometimes tipped with purple. They are covered with fine, short white hairs.

Semp. ‘Gamma’ Green, changing to purple-red in spring. Cute fuzzy

chicks. Small.

Semp. 'Glaucum Minor' Silver blue leaves flushed lavender-pink.

Semp. grandiflorum Bright clear green with tiny sparks of red. From the Alps.

Semp. 'Grapetone' Many pointed leaves of grey-green with a grapetone heart. Small.

Semp. 'Hybrid Globe' Classic rosette of blood red. Large.

Semp. 'Jubilee' Narrow velvet leaves bordered in green. Heavily tufted.

Semp. 'Jungle Fires' Sharply tipped green leaves overlaid with plum. Large. \$6.00

Semp. 'Lentezon' Bright green base leaves are tipped copper red. Heart leaves show much color. Beautiful chicks on long stolons. \$6.00

Semp. 'Tederheid' Green to pink to rose. Glossy leaves form a perfect rosette. Perfect chicks on long stolons. Medium.

Semp. thompsonianum Small, neat, many leaved rosettes producing chicks on long stems.

Semp. 'Woolcott's Variety' Olive green leaves blushed rose. Pretty golden
chicks on red stolons. Large. \$6.00

Semp. 'Zulu' Dark green heart, then colored rich wine red. Winter color is
almost black. Large. \$6.00

Veronica Speedwell. Showy garden plants best grown in a sunny well
drained location.

Veronica 'Crater Lake Blue' 15". Fairly erect on dark green, toothed
leaves on slender spires of dark blue flowers. Withstands partial shade.
Covered in bloom. \$7.00

Veronica prostrata -4-6". A mat forming species with deep blue flowers.
